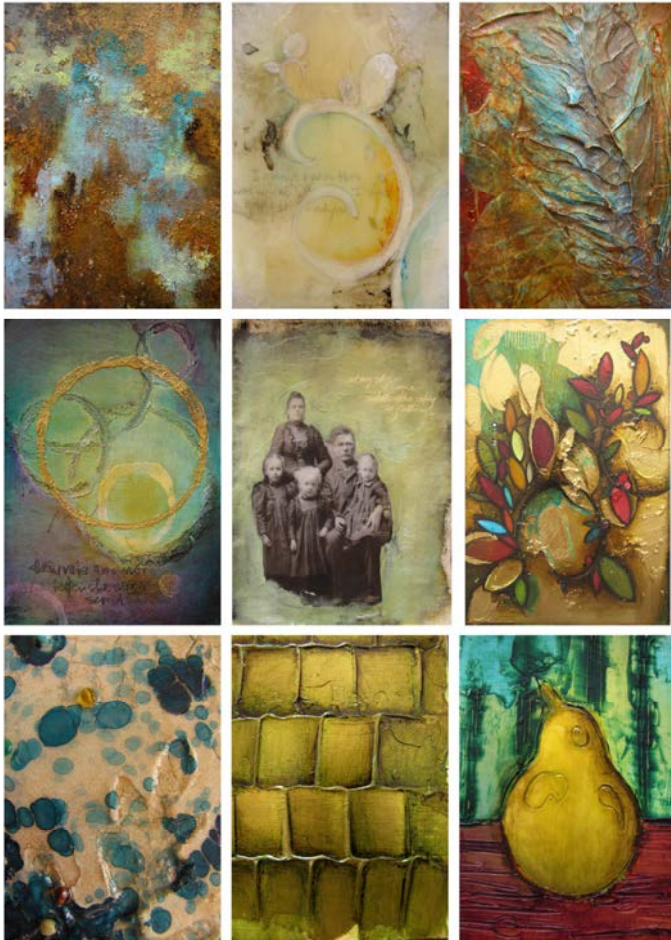

**A**my Shawley is a self-taught, Los Angeles-based artist and has exhibited her work in both solo and group shows in New York, L.A., Minneapolis and Berlin.

The Golden lecture/demo is a two-hour free educational presentation on acrylic paints. The lecture covers information about the different types of pigments, paint formulations and their viscosities, as well as gels, pastes, grounds, color mixing, drying time, health & safety concerns, and much, much more! Various acrylic materials and techniques will be demonstrated to enrich your understanding of the medium, among these you will learn basic tips for how to extend paint to save money and how to mix paints with gels and pastes to create exciting textures! We will also discuss Golden's newest products, including the Open and High Flow paints!

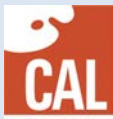
