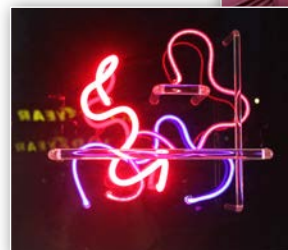

# THE GLENDALE **ART** SCENE

The May 16th Arts & Culture Commission meeting addressed four topics:

- 1.** Commissioners discussed murals on Glendale Public Buildings. Wow, exciting to think that there will be murals to enliven Glendale's color-deprived visage. Roger Dolin, an experienced muralist, discussed the medium and answered questions from the commissioners.
- 2.** Preliminary planning of the Civic Auditorium infrastructure upgrades were discussed. Work on the auditorium is tentatively planned for November, opening the door for a GAA exhibition in the spring. This is huge!
- 3.** Best practices are being refined for RFP and Grant processes to support the Work Plan Projects handled by the city.

Annette Vartanian is adopting nationally used standardized procedures from the Cultural Data Project. I think this is a smart move that will build in efficiency for providing and applying for grants using proven procedures.

- 4.** The Arts & Culture Commission web site redesign is in the works. Long overdue, but we are glad to see some movement.

These activities are near term projects of the Arts and Culture Commission 2013-2015 Work Plan, which is planned to go to the City Council for approval in July.

The GAA will be providing ideas to the A&CC about the utilization of the Civic Auditorium for art shows.

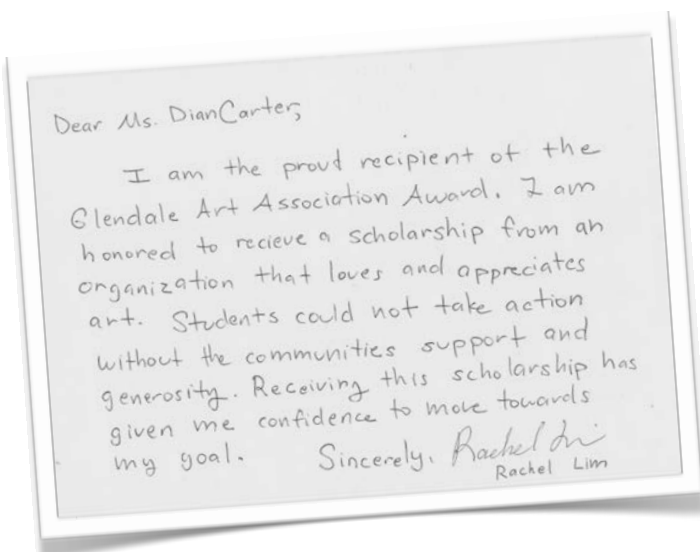
