Quick Tip: Get a Fresh Eye On Your Work

We artists get intensely involved in the magic of creative work—sometimes so intensely involved that we can't see the forest for the trees. We have to find ways of getting a fresh look at what we are doing to deliver our best effort. Here are five ways I've found to get that fresh eye:

- Stand back some distance from your work at fairly regular intervals as you work.
- Use a mirror to peer over your shoulder at the reversed image of your work in progress.
- Ask a a painting buddy to take a look and critique what you are doing.

(I sometimes take a phone photo shot of a work in progress and email to a fellow artist for his/her opinion)

- Check work on the computer to see how it looks in black and white or other formats, or to quickly try different solutions, electronically, to problems encountered on the canvas.
- Just put the work out of sight for a week or two. Find what works best for you to keep those creative juices flowing!




