

QUICK Working from Photographs

• Compose your photo so you don't have a lot to rearrange when you start your painting. Working from a well composed photo will resolve a lot of your problems and you can better concentrate on painting and not rear-

ranging your subjects and composition.

• Use a monitor or a tablet, such as an iPad, to view your photo. You'll get a much better look at the colors by using it than you



will be printing it on paper.

• If you do print out your image to work from BE SURE AND USE PHOTO PAPER. Printing it on regular paper will give you a dull and practically useless reference to work from. Spend the few cents on paper and save yourself the aggravation of having to look at a poorly reproduced photo.
