Peterfield Turpin was born in Boston and grew up in New Hampshire. He attended Dublin School, Choate School and Rhode Island School of Design where he received his Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree in Illustration. He is adept at drawing, oil painting and watercolor—and you will often see him painting outside on large format watercolor sheets. He spent a summer with a German family in Munich through The Experiment in International Living. After two years in the U.S. Army he worked in New York City as a commercial artist and also did free-lance illustrations for magazines.

He moved to Southern California where he worked for ad agencies and commercial art studios. After leaving the commercial art world he has devoted himself to painting pictures in both watercolor and oil. Well known in the Glendale art scene, he belongs to the Verdugo Hills Art Association, Businessmen's Art Institute and the Glendale Art Association. He has participated in many area art shows—winning numerous awards and widespread recognition.

He is married, has a daughter who is a teacher and a 15-year-old grandson. Peterfield is interested in Western history, Natural history, conservation, fishing and cooking.

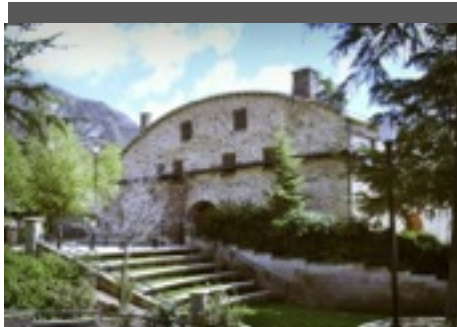

Our 2014 Spring Salon welcomes artist's work in an exciting variety of media including Painting, Photography and Sculpture. Abstract and representational works are welcome. The reception is on Sunday May 11TH, 2014 with hors d'oeuvres, beverages, and music by the Verdugo String Quartet. Proceeds are contributed as scholarships to Glendale visual arts students completing high school and pursuing further education in the arts.

Awards

Cash and Certificate Prizes in 6 categories:

- Representational Art
- Abstract/Fantasy
- Sculpture
- Glendale Images
- Photography
- Eco Art and Found Art

Media Accepted

- All original visual (2-D) media (painting, mixed media, collage, hand-pulled prints, photography, etc.)
- Sculptural and assemblage (3-D) media

Submission Specifications

- Entries must be ORIGINAL work, not reproductions and not previously shown in juried events
- All work must be for sale
- 60% of sales to artists
- 40% of sales to Art Scholarships
- Limit: 2 works per artist
- No Nudes

Paintings:

- Works up to 36" high and 36" wide (frames included)
- Paintings must be framed or gallery wrapped and wired for hanging. No saw tooth hangers.
- Gallery wrapped pieces must have edges painted. No side staples.

Sculpture:

One to two works allowed. Pedestals are artist-provided. Wall mounted sculpture subject to same sizes as paintings.

Jury

- Our judge(s) will select award winners base on: Uniqueness, Competence with Medium, and Aesthetics
- Our judge(s) will also jury works in the exhibition

Juried Entrance Fees

- \$35 for up to 2 works for GAA members
- No refunds for works not accepted
- Non-members are welcome to join GAA at time of check-in by paying the \$40 yearly membership fee
- Open to members of the Glendale Art Association only
- Artist must be at least 18 years of age
