THE GAA 2013 Holiday Salon

What a shame that the Holiday Salon could only stay up for four days. The lovely Eagle Rock Center for the Arts adapted nicely for the eclectic installation that featured art and artists of all varieties. The Glendale Art Association continues to encourage a wide range of art styles and media in its shows. The Opening Reception featured a string quartet playing a repertoire of chamber music and pop selections. The exhibition mounted very diverse works side by side, delivering an exciting art exploration that enlivened the opening reception visitors.

Best in Show, "Pearls" an oil by Lynne Casal contrasted with unusual assemblages by Kimberly Pianzio. The juried show featured everything in between. Of course, appreciation of any artwork is highly subjective. That the GAA is generous with allowing such diverse works to be displayed virtually side by side shows that our

organization is expanding its interests.


Images of artists' works were also displayed on a flat panel monitor. Participants could each display ten images offering visitors a larger body of work than the limit of three pieces allowed for the exhibition.

Of the 70 artists in exhibition more than half were not yet members of the GAA. All tolled, there were 193 entries. 29 prizes were awarded. Best in show \$1000, First Prizes \$100, Seconds \$50, Thirds \$25. Five merchant awards (gift certificates) from \$50 to \$500 dollars in value.

Fong. Tom paints big canvases with big brushes. He gave a virtuoso performance for us with a masterful depiction of an Hawaiian shore scene. Talk about big dynamic moves on the canvas — Tom attacks with both ends of the brush,

credit card edge, palette knife, and you name it. But — no overworking here — and a lot of satisfying abstraction remained in his finished work. An added treat was the collection of large paintings Tom brought for us to see. Beautiful stuff — as well as the notebooks filled with paintings and sketches that Tom showed us. And if that wasn't enough, Tom told fascinating stories of his life and development as an artist.
