He has been and is a member of many prestigious art organizations such as The California Art League, The California Art Club, The international realism guild Of America and currently by invitation The American Society Of Traditional Artists. He is currently represented by The Wally Workman Gallery in Austin TX and the Jack Meier Gallery in Houston TX. Scott Kiche is an emerging and important talent upon the American artistic landscape. Over the years his work has been and continues to be collected by art enthusiasts, corporate buyers and fellow artists alike.

#### Fern Canyon, Griffith Park Wednesday, February 4

Lovely canyon and mountain views, oak trees, burnt trees, and trails leading in various directions. Everything is especially green right now. Nice loop hikes up Fern Canyon Nature Trail and the old Zoo Trail. Located off the fire road above the Merrygo-round. Follow directions into Griffith Park to the Merry-go round, park in Lot #1 at the south end, and walk up the fire road near the entrance of the parking lot.

#### **Central Picnic Area, Griffith Park** Wednesday, February 11

Sycamores are the stars here but there is also a lovely grove of oaks. The sycamores are without leaves, twisted and growing in a tunnel around the picnic area. The oaks line up outside the sycamore grove.

Follow directions to the Merry-go-round but at the turnoff go one block further to the junction of Griffith Park and Zoo Drive. Turn left on Griffith Park Drive and park in the first parking lot on the left, just before Shane's Inspiration.

#### West Canyon, Griffith Park Wednesday, February 18

Canyon, trails, and mountain views plus some lovely leafless trees. Take Los Feliz west to Fern Dell Road. Turn right and drive past the Trails Cafe to the big parking lot. Park at the far end of the parking lot where the road turns and starts its climb to the Observatory. Cross the road and walk down the ravine to the trail area.

#### **Crystal Springs North, Griffith Park** Wednesday, February 25

A beautiful place for trees and birds. We will be working near the golf course. The golf course has beautiful old trees set on hilly green lawns plus there are golfers. Enter Griffith Park and drive to the Ranger Station and the Crystal Springs Picnic area turnoff. When you reach the picnic area turn left and park in the north area of the loop. There is a gate there that gives you access to the golf course area that borders the horse and hiking trail.
