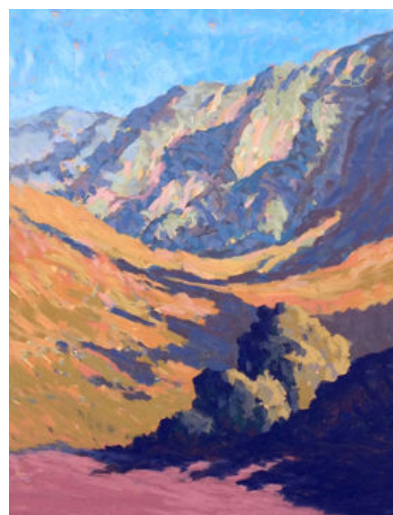
## Next Meeting Demonstrator: **Bruce Trentham**

Bruce Trentham dramatically conveys his love of Southern California coastal and mountain areas in his pastel paintings. Primarily a plein air pastel painter, he strives to develop a composition that invites the viewer to experience light, color and form.

Early training in mediums such as watercolors, oils, acrylics, ceramics and print making lead him to realize his passion for pastels. He has educated himself in the complexities of the medium and with inherent ability skillfully communicates his love for color in his paintings. Bruce is currently teaching Pastel Painting and Drawing at the Emeritus College campus of Santa Monica College and at The Stough Canyon Nature Center in Burbank. And is a board member of the Allied Artists of the Santa Monica Mountains and Seashore. He has given pastel painting demonstrations for; Burbank Art Association, Glendale Art Association, Malibu Art Association, Mid Valley Art League, Pacific Art Guild, Pastel Society of Southern California, Santa Clarita Artists' Association, San Fernando Valley Art Club, Simi Valley Art Association and the Verdugo Art Association.

His paintings have been exhibited in galleries, have won numerous awards and are in private collections throughout Southern California. His paintings have appeared on the TV series, "The Mentalist" and has completed a commission for the California State Parks, Topanga State Park Visitor Center. He is available for individual instruction, workshops, classes, and demonstrations in drawing and pastel painting.

- ◇ There is excellent show at the Brand Library gallery called Perception and Reality. Through Sept. 19. It is mostly abstract work and beautifully executed.



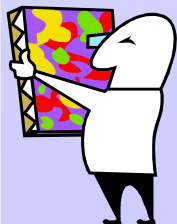
## Notte di Arte Fund Raiser September 16th, 6PM

First off, I gotta tell you that GAA and the San Fernando Valley Art Club are exhibiting paintings at Far Niente Restaurant. "How'd that happen?" You ask.

Jennifer Bentson President of SFVAC and yours truly were having lunch there and chatting with Kevin Berresford, the owner. Jen, never one to hold back, asked Kevin "Can our art clubs bring some paintings for hanging here?" Kevin liked the idea. Got a call from him on Fri Aug 15 to deliver work that Sunday. Jen and I pulled together a few artists from both clubs and hung 27 works. It looks great and the restaurant is getting good feedback on the work.

Sept 16 we are having a fund raising event there called Notte di Arte (Night of Art). Far Niente will donate 15% of whatever members spend on dinner to the GAA and SFVAC charitable funds. Please be sure to tell Far Niente that you are from "Art club" when reserving a table or when you show up at the night of the event. This is where the 15% comes from. The Italian food there is fantastic. There will be \$10-a-bottle wine, \$4 draft beer and a \$20 bottle of wine and pizza special for starving artists. Or bring your own bottle (there is no corkage fee). Drop in about 6pm for a great dinner and a chance to schmooze with some of your art pals. Also you will see 35 artists at work in the bar—they paint there every Tue night. If you are real curious about the Far Niente art caper—and can't wait until Sept 16—drop in anytime for lunch or dinner or for a cool drink at the bar.

The Glendale Art Association is your connection to Glendale's dynamic art scene. Our 2014 Fall Salon welcomes artist's work in an exciting variety of media including Painting and Sculpture. Both abstract and representational work are welcome. The reception is on Oct 5, 2014 with hors d'oeuvres, beverages and live music. A percentage of proceeds support scholarships to Glendale high school students pursuing further education in the Visual Arts.

#### Awards

\$300 for Best in Show

Cash Prizes in following categories:

- Land/Seascapes/Cityscapes
- Portrait/Figurative/Genre
- Abstract/Fantasy
- Still Life/Floral/Animals
- Sculpture

#### Media Accepted

- All original visual media (painting, mixed media, collage)

All sculptural media

#### Eligibility

- Open to all artists, both members and non-members of the Glendale Art Association
- Artists must be at least 18 years of age

#### Submittal specifications

- Entries must be original work, not reproductions and not previously shown in juried events—completed since Jan 2010
- All work must be for sale

50% of sales to artists

25% of sales to Whites Gallery

25% of sales to Art Scholarships

- Whites will handle sales and collect sales tax

- Sales remittances to artists and GAA at end of show

#### Paintings—One to two works allowed per artist

- Total combined length plus width of one or two paintings not to exceed 75", unframed

- Example: submit one painting of 35" x 40" or two paintings of 16" x 20" or any combination of two paintings that does not exceed 75"—when you add up the measurements of the top plus one side of each of the paintings you enter

- Paintings must be framed or gallery wrapped and edge painted and wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers. No side staples

**Sculpture**—One or two works not exceeding 24" x 24" x 36" height allowed. Wall mounted sculpture subject to same sizes as painting

#### Jury

- Our judge will determine acceptance to show and awards winners based on: Uniqueness, Competence with Medium, and Aesthetics

#### Juried Entrance Fees

- \$35 for up to 2 works for GAA members, \$45 for up to 2 works for non-members

- No refunds for works not accepted

- Non-members are welcome to join GAA at time of check-in by paying the \$40 yearly fee

#### How to Enter Your Artwork

- Fill out Juried Art Entry Forms--Attached
- Fill out one form for each entry
- Bring your artwork with form to: Whites Art Framing and Restoration Gallery on Sun. Sep 28, 2014

#### Key Dates/Times

- Sep 28 (Sun) 1pm to 5pm, Artwork take-in at Whites Art Framing and Restoration Gallery
- Sep 30 (Tue) 9am to 5pm, Pick up any works not accepted for the exhibition—artists will be notified by phone if they have works to be picked up
- Oct 2 (Thur) 9am, Exhibition opens to the public
- Oct 5 (Sun) 4pm to 7pm, Reception with Music, Food, and Drinks. Awards presentation at 5:30 pm.
- Oct 30 (Thur) 5pm, Exhibition ends
- Oct 31 (Fri) 9am to 5pm, Artwork Pickup (if hard-ship call gallery for alternative pickup day)

- Art Scholarships awarded to high school visual art students in Glendale from: GAA funds, Sponsor Donations, and proceeds from exhibition sales.
