#### ART FROM THE ASHES

The local non-profit arts organization, ART FROM THE ASHES, is sponsoring temporary installation art exhibits in the City of Glendale. Installations are scheduled to begin during the first part of November based on the theme: YOU ARE HERE. Significant sites will be chosen within the City. Eight artists/installations will be funded over the period of a year, ending in December, 2015. Stipends to cover costs ranging from \$500 to \$5,000 will be awarded.

GAA member, Michael Sheehan, has submitted a modest proposal for the Service Station in the Adams Square Mini-Park in South Glendale. This is the same site where several GAA artists were included in the July Fourth Project in 2012. Should Sheehan's installation proposal be accepted, artists will be recruited to help realize the project. Artists will be paid a small honorarium for work that should take no more than one day. 
