At our next monthly meeting we are going to explore this ideology as it pertains to painting. Using a limited palette and rotating in ten minute intervals, approximately ten volunteer artists will take turns painting from a still life on multiple canvases until the paintings are considered complete by the group (approximately 70 - 80 minutes of painting time). We will discuss the pieces and raffle them off to meeting attendees at the end of the evening.

The demo will stress expression of creative work with free instinctual painting — and of course, everyone not painting will be free to socialize, eat, drink, and kibitz with the participants while they are at work.

GAA was honored at the Diamond Awards on April 29 at a wonderful event at the Main Library auditorium where we were humbled and very appreciative to win the Art Organization Diamond Award. In her introductory remarks for the Glendale Arts Association award, Arts & Culture Commissioner, Arlette DerHovanessian, cited how GAA was a strong advocate for Civic Auditorium improvements to enable art exhibitions there that are now in the 2013-2014 Work Plan budget. Ms. DerHovanessian also pointed out that GAA is contributing five scholarships to high school students this year.

Ten GAA members attended this most enjoyable event (shown at right) at which we were treated to a buffet dinner and a moving recital by Commissioner Armen Keyvanian at the piano. I was presented with a certificate and a crystal plaque that will be on display at the May meeting. This award is recognition of a job well done by all of you. I believe I speak for the whole GAA team when I say this award has strengthened our commitment to the vitality of the Glendale Art and Culture environment. The large photo includes the award winners and city officials involved with arts in Glendale. We met the other awardees and mingled with the city's arts and culture team whom we've come to know during the past year — and are looking forward to more art community interchange in the future.

At our April meeting, Artist Carol Steinberg showed us how to whip out an exciting 18 x 24 floral still life in one session — with great results: beautiful shades of gray supported lively flower colors set off by terrific brushwork. You saw a real pro at work (see below).

Our April show, **Let Your Imagination Fly**, at the La Canada Library show was huge — with 101 paintings hung we couldn't have stuffed another painting in. Nineteen members won ribbons and cash awards. Best of show and a \$200 check went to Marina K. Rehrmann for a supercharged portrait of Lady GaGa.

Our next show in June, **Glendale**, **Real and Imagined**, at Anzoh Gallery will feature hefty cash prizes (\$500 first) and a festive reception. We're portraying our home city in this one! Artists get your track shoes on, you have a month to go.

THE GLENDALE ART SCENE

A funny thing happened on the way to that Arts & Culture Commission: I had lunch at Glendale Pho with Kim Koga Managing Director of the Museum of Neon Art and Michael Sheehan a GAA member. From Michael Kim, I learned of the Adams Square Gas Station where he staged his wonderful Fourth of July show. Kim felt this is perfect place to display MONA's beautiful La Fonda neon sign or possibly other neon pieces set to come to Glendale some time this year.

After lunch, we went to the A&CC meeting where Kim requested that the city make the Adams Square Gas Station available for MONA's installation. The commissioners loved the idea and initiated action to work with the

Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission to make it happen. Wow! I witnessed a microcosmic example of art organizations meeting. Okay — it was just two, but it makes the point; ideas germinating and the city acting, all in the space of a couple hours.

Last month we recommended to the Arts & Culture Commission (A&CC) that the improvements to the Civic Auditorium be ready in time for GAA to have an exhibition there in November. We have learned that there is not enough time for the city to have a plan developed and approved before the end of June — when GAA has to kickoff its preparations for a November exhibition. We'll have a bang up exhibition there in 2014.

Annette Vartanian, Program Supervisor for the A&CC reported she was moving out on the front end of the 2013/15 Work Plan developing request for proposal and grant procedures. Ms. Vartanian is responsible for accomplishment of the 16 Projects/Programs scheduled in this two-year plan — a big job. I offered GAA support to two of these projects where GAA has some experience: RFP development and Capitol Improvements to the Civic Auditorium.

During and after the meeting there were lively discussions with the commissioners of how art organizations in Glendale can come together; interface with each other and the A&CC; and get things done. We'll be back at next month's meeting with concrete ideas for doing this. In the meantime, Members your good ideas will be gratefully accepted.
